Event HQ Bodle Street Green Village Hall BN27 4RE – Open from 9am. TQ 650145 Map Ref: OS Landranger 199 (approx 4 miles north east of Hailsham). Thank you in advance for not wearing cycling shoes or cleats in the hall.

Car Parking The village hall car park shares a common entrance with the car park for the White Horse Inn. **Please park only in the village hall spaces which are marked in white.** The White Horse parking spaces are marked in yellow and are not to be used under any circumstances. When the hall car park is full please park sensibly in the road – village hall side only.

Race Numbers Numbers will be available at the event HQ. Please collect your number when you sign on. Notice of any additional hazards to be aware of on the course will be displayed next to the signing on sheet. After the event please return your number to the HQ in exchange for a cup of tea or coffee.

Warming Up Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the event has started. Please show courtesy towards the churchgoers at the Church of St John the Evangelist just before the start, and at the Ebenezer Chapel before the finish.

Start Proceed out of the car park and turn right. The start is located approx 300 yards south of the village hall.

Prizes Cash prizes will be awarded at the HQ immediately following the event.

This is a qualifying event for

- ESCA Points Competition 30 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 30th place for first claim riders from ESCA affiliated clubs. The individual points earned by each rider are totalled and awarded to their respective club.
- **ESCA Trophies** The fastest rider from an ESCA affiliated club will be awarded the Page Tankard at the annual prize presentation.
- Sussex SPOCO 120 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 120th place for first claim riders from Sussex CA affiliated clubs.

Please pay attention to the following CTT regulations/recommendations

- Helmets CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under 18s. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.
- **Competitors' Machines** It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.
- **Competitors' Vehicles** No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish.
- **Results** No times will be given out at the finish.



Competitors must exercise care when


- Joining the A271 at Windmill Hill

Hill Prime

This is on the unclassified road between the left turn from the A271 and Ponts Green. It is approx 1 mile in length and includes Agony Hill – a well known spectator point in the original ESCA Hardriders event which started in 1947. The start of the hill prime will be indicated by a blue flag and finish by a white flag. This is what you've got to look forward to!

Field Placement

Using either the last three season's results* from this event, or estimates based on information available, riders have been seeded in the following order: 0s, 5s, 1s and 6s. With the necessary adjustments for early starts and travelling arrangements, the remainder of the field is generally set to prevent too much fragmentation over a sporting course.
